- Increased leadership opportunities for pupils throughout the school.

- Develop sustainable high-quality PE lessons throughout the school.
- Increased access for all children to active play equipment and the development of more structured play.
- Particular emphasis on providing Foundation Stage with greater opportunities for developmental child initiated activities.
- Increased diversity of after school clubs to raise school participation levels.
- To provide a broader experience in a range of sports and activities to all pupils.
- Improved awareness of personal health and wellbeing within our school and community.

Buy into “Basic Passport Membership”	£650	To make available further extracurricular/ inter school competitive activities for children throughout the school.			
Healthy Schools Week. Continue our school tradition of a week of physical activity and events at the end of the summer term. Consider using outside providers to offer more opportunities to the children to experience different activities.	£1000	Opportunities for all children to experience fun physical activities during a week of high-profile sports at the end of the summer term.			
Community Club Links. Identify opportunities to foster closer links with local sports clubs.	£0	Continue to identify and raise the profile of local clubs with a network of in school pupil representatives. Consider inviting local clubs into school.
